Athens, May 26, 2026 – Premia Properties once again supported the SYMPLEFSI NGO “Crossing” mission, which took place from April 23 to May 3, 2026, reaffirming in practice its long-standing commitment to social contribution and support for Greece’s remote island communities.

This year’s mission, in which Mr. Nikolaos Baziotis, CFO/CIO of Premia Properties, also participated, traveled with a fleet of 11 inflatable boats and approximately 100 volunteers, visiting the islands of Sikinos, Folegandros, Irakleia, Donousa, Thymaina, Fournoi, Oinousses, and Psara. During the Crossing mission, free medical services were provided, cultural activities were organized, and important infrastructure projects were carried out for the benefit of the local communities.

As part of its ongoing sponsorship collaboration with SYMPLEFSI, Premia Properties contributed to the completion of the renovation works at the Donousa Primary School, which had commenced in 2025, as well as the repair and maintenance works at the island’s medical clinic.
